Internal Revenue Code Section 25C**

The Inflation Reduction Act, 2022 (P.L. 117-169) amended section 25C of the tax code, which provides tax credits for the installation of “qualified energy property” for residential heating and cooling equipment meeting or exceeding the highest efficiency tier (not including any advanced tier) established by the Consortium for Energy Efficiency (CEE). Trane U.S. Inc. (“Trane”) certifies that the products or system families listed below include models that meet the efficiency requirements according to the Air Conditioning, Heating & Refrigeration Institute’s (“AHRI”) system rating process when installed as part of a matched system, that may be eligible for the 2025 section 25C tax credit if placed in service by December 31, 2025.
